Messina Highlights & MuMe Museum

Departure from the Duomo for a scenic drive to Cape Peloro, the northernmost point of Sicily and the closest tip to mainland Italy. Enjoy a short photo stop to take in the breathtaking views over the Strait of Messina.

Return to the city centre for a guided visit of the Regional Museum of Messina (MuMe), the largest museum in Southern Italy. The museum preserves the city's rich artistic heritage, showcasing masterpieces that survived both the 1908 earthquake and the bombings of World War II.

Its collections span from the Middle Ages through the Renaissance and Baroque periods, featuring works by Caravaggio, Antonello da Messina, and Montorsoli.

A dedicated section illustrates the devastating impact of the 1908 earthquake through rescued fragments and a striking "before and after" display of the city's transformation.
