Etna excursion

Comfortable walking shoes and warm casual clothing are recommended

Meeting point: Messina Cathedral (Duomo)

Time: 09:30 a.m. - 05:00 p.m.

Departing from Messina Cathedral, the excursion begins with a short drive through the city and continues along the eastern motorway, following the scenic Ionian coastline.

The route then ascends Mount Etna via a panoramic inland road, passing the towns of Giarre, Santa Venerina, and Zafferana Etnea, through landscapes of orchards, vineyards, and wooded slopes. Along the way, you will observe striking lava flows from past eruptions, frozen into vast black rivers descending the mountain.

Arrival at the Silvestri Craters (approx. 1,900 m / 6,400 ft) on the southern slopes of Mount Etna, Europe's highest and most active volcano. From this vantage point, enjoy spectacular views over the Gulf of Catania.

Free time for a short coffee break or souvenir shopping before continuing to a local Etna winery. Visit the estate followed by a traditional Sicilian lunch with wine tasting.

In the afternoon, return to Messina.
